Short biography (1'000 characters)

Elie Jolliet is a Swiss musician, church musician in the church district Köniz and assistant organist at the city church Saint-François in Lausanne. In June 2018, he graduated from the “Haute École de Musique de Lausanne” (HEMU) with a Master of Arts in Music Performance. He passed the class taught by Benjamin Righetti with distinction. Baroque music, playing the harpsichord and choral conducting (certificate CH I in November 2018) are his special interests. He maintains an active concert schedule as soloist, accompanist, orchestral organist as well as conductor.

He was an award winner and scholarship holder of the Migros instrumental competition in 2016 and a finalist of the Mendelssohn organ competition in 2015 in Aarau.

In addition to the musical career he also writes articles, among others, for the church music newspaper “Music und Gottesdienst”. Since August 2017 he is a member of the board and secretary for the International fellowship for hymnological studies.
